

Watercolor Collage Supply List

- Bring your regular watercolor supplies that you normally use
- Watercolor paper 140# Cold press at least 1-2 sheets (I will also have paper for sale if you do not have \$4 per sheet)
- Paint board, half sheet size okay
- Disposable drinking cups small for mixing glue (plastic is best)
- Two water containers for water
- scissors
- Crayons, oil pastels, colored pencils, and watercolor pencils **if you have them.** I hope that some of us will and we can share. Do not go out and buy sets. I bring some that I will share.
- Bring any oriental paper (I will also have available for purchase an oriental variety pack \$10), odds and ends of collagable papers, old paintings to rip up and collage, tissue paper, magazines, any interesting textural papers. In other words, anything interesting you think you might like to collage.
- Gloss or matte medium. Elmers glue will be okay but not school glue.
- Old stiff paint brush or cheap brush to spread glue (bristle brush no larger than 1 inch)
- Freezer paper is handy to cover your art board to protect from glue
- If you don't like to get your hands messy be sure and bring a pair of disposable gloves
- Paper towels
- Trash bag to put at your table to throw trash in, and a table cover.
- Pencil and notebook
- We will be working small 7 1/2 x 7 1/2"
